

Reference Object Single-family House in Oberhausen-Rheinhausen, Germany: External Thermal Insulation

- Energy-efficient renovation of a single-family house built in 1972
- Building floor space: 300 m<sup>2</sup>
- Insulation thickness: 16 cm with WLG032
- Additional measures: new heating, new windows, solar heating (financed with state funding)
- Primary energy demand of natural gas: 17,642 m<sup>3</sup>/a
- Final energy demand: approx. 60 KWh/m<sup>2</sup>
  → approx. 35% of original demand
